We are writing pursuant to our earlier correspondence about the impending expiry of the licence of Fighting Fathers Ministries Pty Ltd for the use of the Parish Hall. We previously advised, in our letter dated 27 September 2021, that Fighting Fathers Ministries Pty Ltd was required to remove all its equipment from the hall by the expiration date of the licence (i.e. 28 December 2021). In light of the terms of the Termination Agreement dated 19 April 2020, which specified 31 December 2021 as the termination date for the licence, we are prepared to extend the date by which you must remove all the equipment, including signage and photos on the walls, to Friday 31 December 2021.

From Monday 20 December, the Sunnyfield program for people with disability will be in recess for the holiday period, so you can have free access to the hall until Friday 31 December. After that date, you will no longer be able to gain access to the hall. Any equipment, signage or photos still in the hall after that date will be removed at your expense.

We would stress that said equipment does not include the boxing ring, which was purchased using funds from a New South Wales Clubs' Grant in 2015. Under the terms of that grant, the parish may only donate it to a not-for-profit, community incorporated organisation. The parish cannot donate the boxing ring to Fighting Fathers Ministries Pty. Ltd., because it does not qualify as a not-for-profit organisation.

The wardens and parish council have identified a suitable organisation which works with disadvantaged youth in regional NSW.
